Academic Calendar and Instructional Days Policy

The Academy’s published academic calendar is subject to change at any time at the discretion of school administration. It may be adjusted due to severe weather, natural disasters, public health emergencies, governmental directives, or other force majeure circumstances beyond the Academy’s control. In such cases, the Academy reserves the right to revise the academic calendar, implement make-up days, extend the school year, modify instructional schedules, or utilize alternative instructional delivery methods as necessary to meet required instructional hours.

All calendar revisions will be communicated promptly to parents, students, and staff through official Academy communication channels.

Central Christian Academy provides a complete academic program for all grade levels K–12 in compliance with Florida private school instructional requirements. The Academy calendar includes a minimum of 170 instructional school days and the required instructional hours.
